The "Strong and Free Awards" recognize those who've gone above and beyond in their service, embodying the spirit of Alberta and our party's values. If you know a member whose efforts deserve recognition, we encourage you to nominate them. Details on the nomination process are at the end of this document. Awards will be presented at the party's Annual General Meeting in Red Deer taking place November 1-2, 2024.



Exceptional Fundraiser Award

This award honours a member's steadfast dedication to their Constituency Association, recognizing their instrumental role in raising the funds necessary for electoral success and to spread the United Conservative message.

Regional Volunteer of the Year Award (five awards)

This award celebrates a volunteer who consistently goes above and beyond, epitomizing dedication, selflessness, and passion. Not only are they ever ready when needed, but their exemplary service and infectious enthusiasm make them a joy to work with. They stand as a pillar of the United Conservative Party in their region, setting a remarkable standard and inspiring those around them.

Exceptional Constituency Association President

Outstanding Chief Financial Officer Award

The Next Generation Award recognizes rising young stars in our Conservative movement and helps them further their involvement with a \$500 award donated annually by Past President Erika Barootes. To receive the award, you must be a current UCP member, 26 years of age or under, and not an employee of a minister's office, caucus, or the party.

Submission requirements

Individuals submitting nominations for these awards must include an essay of no more than 500 words. This essay should highlight the unique qualities that make the nominee exceptional, complemented by specific examples of the nominee in action.
