The “Strong and Free Awards” recognize those who’ve gone above and beyond in their service, embodying the spirit of Alberta and our party’s values. Awards will be presented at the party’s Annual General Meeting in Edmonton taking place November 28–30, 2025.

Exceptional Fundraiser Award

This award honours a member’s steadfast dedication to their Constituency Association, recognizing their instrumental role in raising the funds necessary for electoral success and to spread the United Conservative message.

Regional Volunteer of the Year Award (five awards)
